Before attending your scheduled clinic please take note of the following advice for participants attending RMPP events:

1. Do not attend any event if you are feeling unwell.
2. Practice good hygiene always. This means:
 - Covering coughs and sneezes with disposable tissues or coughing/sneezing into your elbow
 - Disposing of used tissues appropriately in a bin
 - Washing hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water and drying them thoroughly, or using hand sanitizer:
 - Before eating or handling food
 - After using the toilet
 - After coughing, sneezing, blowing your nose or wiping children's noses
 - After touching public surfaces.
3. Implement social distancing (keep at least 1 metre away).
4. Limiting alcohol and drug use (this may affect your ability to adequately follow the advice above).
